Consent, as it relates to adoption, refers to the agreement by a parent, or a person or agency acting in place of a parent, to relinquish a child for adoption and release all rights and duties with respect to that child Consent to adoption is regulated by state statutes, not by federal laws, and states

Accessing Adoption Records Overview The Virginia Department of Social Services keeps a permanent record of all adoptions finalized in Virginia since July 1, 1942 In addition, if the adoptee was placed for adoption through an agency with the legal authority to consent to the adoption, that agency may have a copy of the record
